Construction in the United States is on the Rise

Ten years after the Great Recession put a screeching halt to major construction projects across the country, the United States is finally experiencing a resurgence in construction projects in many of its major cities. Due in part to investments coming in from both domestic and international sources, new skyscrapers will be gracing the skylines of cities like Chicago, New York, Los Angeles, and more. The list provided here describes the top thirteen construction projects currently underway, and many other major cities are prepping for major developments of their own.





One Vanderbilt in New York City (above) is a staggering 1,400-foot-tall glass building that is poised to tower over Midtown East. One Vanderbilt will include an observation deck at around 1,000 feet, as well as apartments for tenants and a public plaza on the lower levels. Construction began in late 2016. The Washington State Convention Center in Seattle (*left*) is another major construction development that is currently underway. The ambitious project will add 1.2 million square feet of exhibition and

meeting space, a 30-story residential tower with 428 units, a 16-story office building, and new retail and public spaces all along the exterior. It is the largest project in the city's history. To learn more about this record-breaking building, <u>click here</u>.

Another notable project on the horizon is the expansion and renovation of the New Orleans Children's Hospital (right). At a price tag of \$225 million, the multi-year development will include a new same-day surgery unit, a cardiac intensive care unit, a neonatal cardiac intensive care unit, a cancer center, a 400-car garage, and a newly designed entrance and lobby.
