

All are designed for AC service. The above model numbers may be followed by "M", "L", "D", "R" and ending with "S" or "Z".



CONTROL PANEL PARTS IDENTIFICATION

- 1. Power Switch
- 2. Yellow Light-Power
- 3. Thermostat
- 4. Thermometer

HOW TO INSTALL UNIT:

- 1. Place cabinet near warm ovens. Do *NOT* put in drafty areas or near ventilating systems.
- 2. Plug cord end into proper wall outlet.

HOW TO START UNIT:

- 1. Turn the POWER switch on. The *yellow* light will turn on.
- 2. Turn thermostat to #10.
- 3. Preheat cabinet for 30 minutes.
- 4. Put food into cabinet.
- 5. Turn thermostat to #8 and close door.

NOTE: No. 8 setting = approx. 190°F (88°C) No. 6 setting = approx. 165°F (74°C)

Proper food holding temperature is 140°F (60°C) or higher. The thermometer shows the temperature inside.

TO TURN OFF UNIT:

- 1. Turn thermostat off.
- 2. Turn the POWER switch off.
- 3. The *yellow* light will go out.

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MAINTENANCE

HOT UNIT REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Unplug power cord from wall outlet.
- 2. Pull entire unit out the front of the cabinet.



HOW TO CLEAN THE CABINET:



- 1. Allow cabinet to cool.
- 2. Remove Hot unit from cabinet.
- 3. Do NOT use abrasives or harsh chemicals.

Cleaning Notes:

- 1. Wipe up spills as soon as possible.
- 2. Clean cabinet regularly to avoid heavy dirt build-up.
- 3. Make a test spot with cleaner.
- 4. Follow manufacturer's directions on cleaner.
- 5. Do not mix cleaners.
- 6. Avoid drips and splashes.

HOW TO CLEAN UNIT:

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TROUBLE-SHOOTING CHART:

FAILURE	POSSIBLE CAUSE
1. Yellow light at switch does NOT light.	1a. Circuit breaker/fuse to wall outlet is blown.
	1b. Cord is unplugged from wall outlet.
	1c. Switch is "OFF".
2. Unit does not heat.	2a. Thermostat set too low or is " <i>OFF</i> ".
	2b. Switch is "OFF".
3. Unit gets too hot or won't shut off.	3a. Defective electrical parts. UNPLUG UNIT FROM
_	WALL OUTLET.
4. Blower does not work or makes noise.	4a. Defective blower.

NOTE: Optional digital thermometer will flash if cabinet temperature is below 140° F or above 250° F. Call the factory if you need different settings.

If cause is none of the above, refer to our list of Authorized Service Centers, FL-1400.
